Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject and references cited above, I am to submit that the Advisory issued by the National Commission for Women (NCW) regarding measures for prevention, care, rehabilitation and access to justice for acid attack survivors has been received and duly noted by Alhaz Sunai Bibi Choudhury College, Udali Bazar, Lanka, Hojai.

In compliance with the instructions contained in the above-mentioned communication, the actionable points specified in Annexure-I, Para 3(f) and 6(b) have been taken into consideration and necessary measures have been undertaken at the institutional level.

The following actions have been taken by the College:

1. The contents of the NCW Advisory have been brought to the notice of the teaching and non-teaching staff and students of the College.
2. Awareness has been created among the students regarding prevention of acid attacks, violence against women, personal safety, legal rights and the support and rehabilitation mechanisms available to survivors.
3. The College has sensitized its students and staff regarding the need for maintaining a safe, respectful and violence-free environment within the institution.

4. The existing grievance redressal mechanisms of the College have been sensitized to ensure that any complaint relating to violence, harassment, threats or other such incidents is addressed promptly and appropriately.
5. Students and staff have been advised to immediately report any incident or threat relating to acid attacks or violence against women to the appropriate authority so that necessary action may be initiated without delay.
6. The College shall extend all possible institutional support to any survivor of an acid attack, including assistance in accessing medical care, counseling, rehabilitation and legal support, wherever required.
7. The College shall continue to organize suitable awareness and sensitization programs from time to time for prevention of violence against women and for creating awareness about the rights and rehabilitation measures available to acid attack survivors.
8. The College shall continue to comply with all relevant instructions, guidelines and directions issued by the Government of Assam, Directorate of Higher Education, Assam, National Commission for Women and other competent authorities in this regard.

In view of the above, the **Action Taken Report** is hereby submitted for kind information and record. The College assures that necessary preventive, awareness and support measures shall continue to be implemented in the institution in the interest of the safety, dignity and welfare of the students and staff.

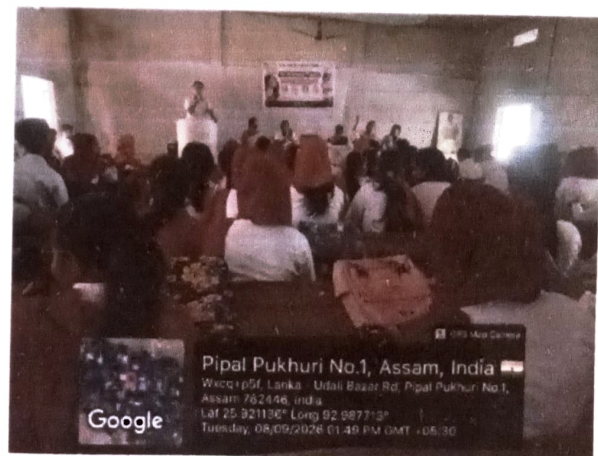
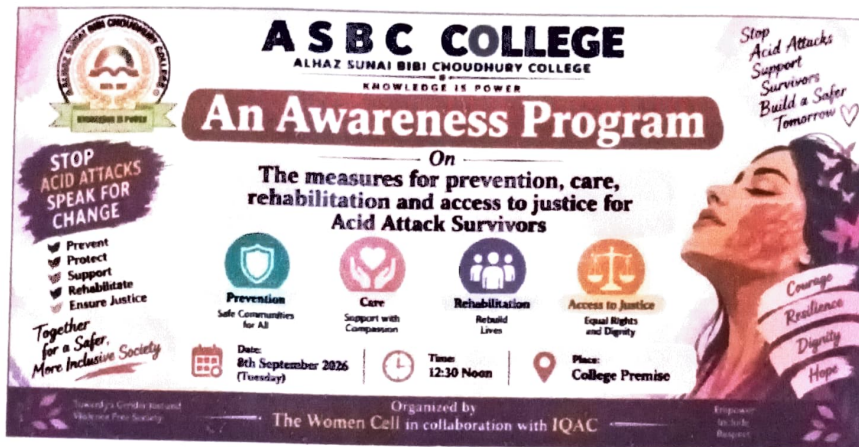

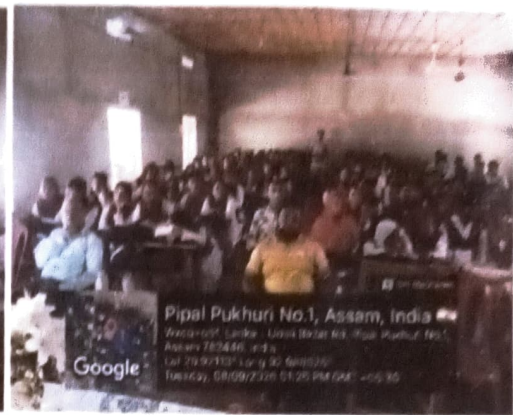
