Programme Highlights:

The expert session started on 11a.m. and it was co-ordinated by Dr. Nazbin Salma Hussain, dept. of Education.

The guest speaker Hurmat Ali Laskar motivated the beginning of the session with his self-credentials to the audience. Then he slowly and gradually proceeded to the

life juncture that he struggled with. He shared his entrepreneurial journey in the field of plantation drive and nursery management. He said that while undergoing his life journey, he encountered with a good number challenges but he did not loss at his heart rather he tackled the problems and went ahead. He also highlighted how he generated an idea of innovation and assessed with cool mind and later he conceptualized and planned for it and capitalized it for goal oriented profit. He highlighted that plantation drive in the context of innovative start up, offers diverse career opportunities. That blend traditional agriculture with modern Agri-tech, sustainability and data driven management.

Then students also shared their ideas on innovation and start up. They also shared their best tools to start up, innovate and how to plan it. In short they have been encouraged by the tips given by the resource person, Hurmat Ali Laskar, Owner of Himalaya Nursery, Bordoloi Pathar.

The session frequently featured interactive elements, including Q&A sessions to provide students with practical guidance on areas like funding, strategy and social entrepreneurship.
