Objectives of the Event:

International Women's Day (March 8) is celebrated to honor the social, economic, cultural, and political achievements of women while acting as a global call to action for accelerating gender parity. It marks a day of reflection on progress, advocacy for women's rights, and unity in addressing ongoing gender inequality and abuse.

The International Women's Day was celebrated on 8th March 2026 at Alhaz Sunai Bibi Choudhury College. It started at 10 am onwards and it had been a whole day program. “As we know every year on 8 March around the world International Women's Day is celebrated with a poignant and relevant theme. This year we have come out to observe the day with the superb theme “Give to Gain.” The literal meaning of the phrase Give to Gain is the more you input in women the more you get. Thus it calls for practical action, such as providing mentorship, leadership, equal pay and opportunities to women whereby a nation becomes developed when women also will be empowered and this is the grand vision of **VIKSHIT BHARAT 2047**, it's 'a whole of government' approach to gear up the field **STEM** where **S**-for Science **E**- for Engineering, **T**-for Technology ,and **M**-for Mathematics.

However, the speaker says that today is the occasion to realize and conceive the great contribution of women to us and to this world. Their contribution is cashless, and painless in their family. At its root level, a woman is kind hearted, blend of emotional intelligence, resilience, and compassion and the most caring. So we should respect them, we should love them in return.”

He said that a woman of today and a woman of yesterday is different. It had long been women are fighting for their rights and equal place along the line of masculinity, they were only restricted within the Four walls. They are oppressed at the cruel clutch of male-dominated society; they are left unpaid, unloved and unlearned and so on. But now they are no more the symbol of oppression, they are no more the symbol of confession. It has been reversed and adopted the dynamic attitude working at their own pace and eases. They have learned how to live independently .They have come out from the four walls and competing with outer world to survive like that of a man. They are proving their talent, strength and their leadership along the line of masculinity. **They refute and reject the concept of “Phallus” and walking beside man.**

Then the rest of the teachers –participants also gave their valuable speech on International Women’s Day. Key activities include recognition events for female faculty, debates competition, Quiz competition and Contemporary speech are being held to promote gender equality. 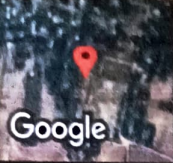
Outcomes:
