### **IDENTITY CARD:**

### **CLASSES: Offline and Online**

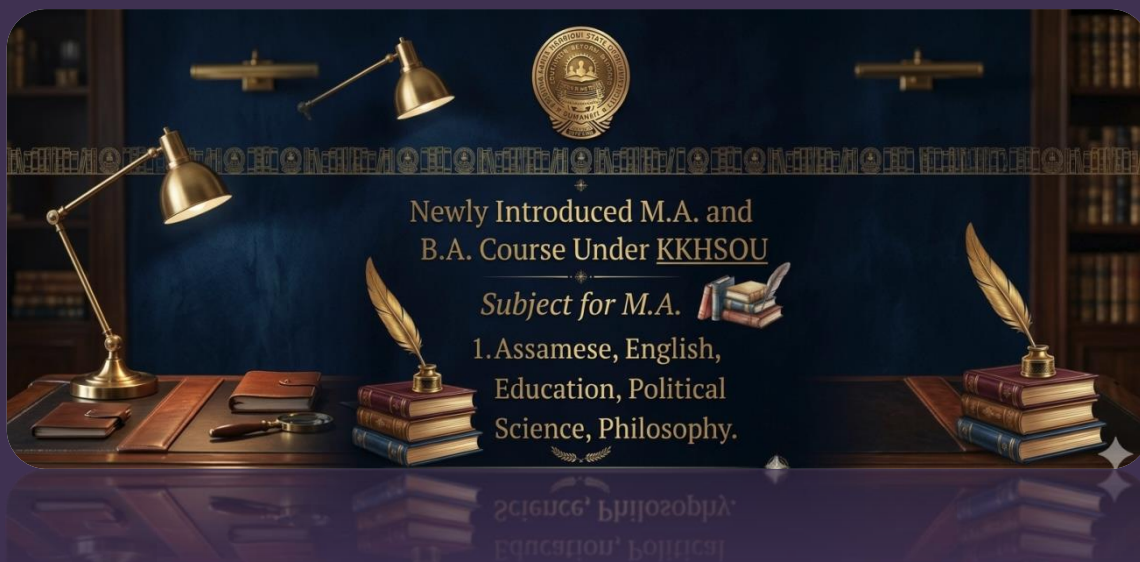

### RABINDRANATH THAKUR VISHWAVIDYALAYA FOUR YEAR UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMM(RTU-FYUGP) UNDER NEP-2020

The Rabindranath Thakur Vishwavidyalaya has adopted Undergraduate course Curriculum (UGCF) Under National Education policy 2020. It is a structure for four year undergraduate programs in different disciplines with multiple exit options.

#### Design of Course :

The categories of courses and requirement of minimum credits for four year degree as per UGC are as follows:

## IMPORTANT POINT:

1. If a student opts to exit after completion of 1<sup>st</sup> year, he/she may be awarded UG Certificate with a minimum of 40 credits earned. In addition to that, the student will require to complete a mandatory vocational course of 4 credits during summer vacation of first year.
2. If as students opts to exit after competition of 2<sup>nd</sup> year. He/she may be awarded a UG Diploma with a minimum of 80 credits earned. In addition to that, the student will require to complete a mandatory vocational course of 4 credits during summer vacation of 2<sup>nd</sup> year.
3. If a student opts to exit after completion of either 1<sup>st</sup> year or completion of 2<sup>nd</sup> year, he/she may be allowed to re-enter within three year and complete the degree program within the stipulated maximum period of 7 years.
4. If a student opts to exit after completion of three years securing 120 credits, he/she will be eligible for UGC degree with major discipline without Major Courses.
5. For four year Major Courses degree the major subject /discipline requires 80 credits and the minor subject/ discipline requires 30 credits. The students who exits after completion of 6<sup>th</sup> semester / 3<sup>rd</sup> year, he/she requires 60 credits in the major subject/discipline and 24 credits in the minor subject/ discipline.
6. Students who intend to complete 4 year degree programme will have to options in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> semesters.
  - i. Students who choose research in 4<sup>th</sup> year are to study DSC-16, DSC-17 and DSC-18 of 4 credits each and to complete a dissertation/ project of 4 credits mandatorily in 7 semester.  
Accordingly, in 8<sup>th</sup> semester thus students will study DSC-19, DSC-20 of 4 credits each and to complete dissertation / project of 8 credits.
  - ii. Students who don't choose Research will study DSC-21\*, DSC-22\*, And DSC-22\* mandatorily in lieu dissertation/ project in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> semester in addition to (DSC-16-DSC-20) leading to Major Courses without research.
7. Student who will complete Four Year Degree Programme with dissertation/ project will be awarded Bachelor dissertation/ project will be awarded Bachelor degree of Major Courses.

### **PROCEDURE OF ADMISSION**

- A. The Admission is Online. The site is [www.asbcc.ac.in](http://www.asbcc.ac.in)
- B. Admission to the college shall be based on Merit.
- C. Only those students who satisfy the eligibility criteria as determined by Assam Higher Secondary Education Council and Rabindranath Tagore University for Higher secondary and Degree Courses respectively will be eligible for the Admission.
- D. Minimum qualifying marks for opting for a major by a student of his/her choice is 40% in the concern subject and overall 45% marks in his/her last qualifying examination.
- E. Applicants seeking admission in to Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) offered by the College should go through web portal
- F. <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in> & [www.asbcc.ac.in](http://www.asbcc.ac.in). Thereby the Applicants are also directed to download the prospectus and read it thoroughly before filling the online Application.
- G. A Students seeking admission must submit his/her duly filled in Admission form within the stipulated date as fixed by the College Authority. Incomplete and delayed submission of Application forms will be summarily rejected without intimation to the candidate.

- H. The Applicant shall have to upload marks sheet caste Certificate, Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended, Admit card, Income Certificate (for free Admission)/ Certificate if any and other relevant along with the applications.
- I. At the time of Admission, the Candidate shall have to provide the following original Documents before the Admission Committee.
- i) Original Marks Sheet of the last qualifying examination.
  - ii) Original Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
  - iii) Admit Card of the last qualifying examination.
  - iv) Caste Certificate
- J. Seats for SC,ST,OBC, MOBC, PWDs outstanding sports persons etc. are reserved as per provision of departmental rules.
